ACS Tournaments Presents the Dynamite Baits “Tournament of Champions”

Carp Angling Elite Compete at Lake Hominy, Oklahoma

Bartlesville OK—Anglers from Illinois, Texas, Ohio and as far away as Romania are competing in the fourth ultra-challenge carp-fishing “Tournament of Champions” at Lake Hominy, Oklahoma next week. Organizers from ACS Tournaments announced earlier this summer that the October 23rd-27th competition has been expanded from 72-consecutive hours to 100-consecutive-hours based on the success of the previous years’ format. The tournament is presented by the Oklahoma-based ACS Tournaments in partnership with the English carp bait manufacturer Dynamite Baits.

“Hominy has been an ideal location for a tournament of this kind,” says David Moore, tournament director. “The lake consistently produces nice common carp and the conditions make the lake an optimum challenge for these elite anglers.”

Seventeen two-person teams, including Texas state record holder and America’s most moneyed carp angler, Al St. Cyr with partner Tommy Riley, are expected to compete representing Dynamite Baits. Prizes include a cash prize pool estimated to be around \$7,500 plus carp fishing tackle and gear provided by sponsors Enterprise Tackle, Speed Tech Instruments, Anglers Edge and Big Carp Tackle.

ACS Tournaments, LLC is based in Bartlesville, Oklahoma and is under the direction of David Moore. Moore is considered a carp angling visionary in North America and the foremost authority on carp angling in the United States. He is a world-class carp angler having competed in France, Romania and other noted overseas venues. He is a founding director of the American Carp Society.

ACS Tournaments is dedicated to catch-and-release angling of common carp through the promotion of tournaments which exemplify good sportsmanship, sound environmentalism, stewardship of our lands and waters as well as education of the sport.
